**The Government encourages giving to charity through its Gift Aid scheme. Gift Aid donations are regarded as having basic rate tax deducted by the donor. Trauma Aid UK take your donation, which is money you have already paid tax on, and reclaim the basic rate tax from HMRC on its 'gross' equivalent i.e. the amount before basic rate tax was deducted.

If you pay income tax at the higher rate, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return form if you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you.

The Declaration covers gifts made in any form – Standing Order, cheque, PayPal or cash – so long as they can be identified as made by you. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income or capital gains, or you change your name or home address, or if you want to cancel the declaration, please notify the Trauma Aid UK Treasurer at the address above.
